**Ph.D. ADMISSION 2019 - 2020**

Applications are invited for admission to various Ph.D. programmes from eligible candidates as per the vacancies available in the various subjects. Candidates shall apply to the Research Centre (RC) for the Ph.D. Programme in the prescribed format (Download from website: [www.gvishamt.org](http://www.gvishamt.org)) i.e. Appendix-5 along with admission processing fee of Rs. 1000/- on or before 27<sup>th</sup> December, 2019 and submit hard copy of application form along with necessary documents to the respective Research centre (concerned departments) personally, for document verifications.

**Eligibility:**

- 1) A Candidate having 55% marks in PG, shall be eligible to apply for Ph.D. programme subject to fulfillment of the conditions mentioned in forthcoming paragraphs.
- 2) A relaxation of 5% of marks, from 55% to 50%, or an equivalent relaxation of grade, may be allowed for those belonging to SC / ST / OBC (non-creamy layer) / Differently-abled and other categories of candidates as per the decision of the Commission from time to time, or for those who had obtained their Master's degree prior to 19th September, 1991. The eligibility marks of 55% (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) and the relaxation of 5% to the categories mentioned above are permissible based only on the qualifying marks without including the grace mark procedures.
- 3) Shall have qualified the Ph.D. Entrance Test (PET) conducted by the University. Provided that, eligible candidates satisfying any of the following criteria shall be exempted from the Ph.D. Entrance Test –
  - a) UGC/CSIR-NET (Including JRF) / SLET / GATE / GPAT / M.Phil. Qualified.
  - b) Teacher Fellowship.

## **Interview:**

**List of eligible candidates will be displayed on Institute website along with the schedule of interview. Candidate should see website regularly for updates.**

- ❖ The Candidate shall have to appear for interview before the Research Advisory Committee (RAC) for discussing proposed research interest / area of doctoral degree. The allocation of research supervisor for a selected research scholar shall be decided by the concerned RAC depending on the number of scholars per research supervisor, the available specialization among the supervisors and research interests of the scholars as indicated by them at the time of interview.
- ❖ **Vacancies available in various subjects in different faculties and list of recognized supervisors and fee structure: See notices uploaded on our website.**
- ✚ In case if RAC feels that topic selected by the candidate is interdisciplinary then a co-supervisor may be allowed who must be the recognized supervisor of the University.
- ✚ RC shall display the list of selected candidates along with the allocated supervisors who shall be acting as internal evaluators for the Ph.D. thesis. After the interview process, the selected candidate shall confirm the admission by **paying the prescribed fees** and depositing **essential original documents, (before 8<sup>th</sup> January, 2020 as per Appendix 5B).**

## **Course work:**

After having been admitted, the scholar shall have to complete a course work of one semester duration (16 weeks) at respective Research Center. However, the scholar who desires to carry the course work at other Research Center within the University area, the scholar may do so with prior permission of both the Research Centers.

Scholar who has already completed M.Phil. (as per UGC Regulation 2009) shall be exempted from the Ph.D. course work.

- ✚ The syllabus of the Ph.D. course work, teaching scheme and scheme of examination shall be as prescribed by the University.
- ✚ Other rules as per Govt. norms and Institute norms directed by Director of Institute
