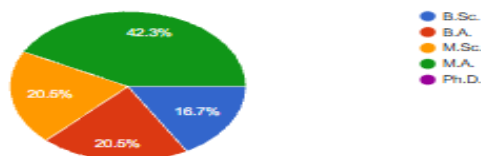
A Alumni will have to respond to all the questions given in the following format with her/his sincere effort and thought. Her/his identity will not be revealed.

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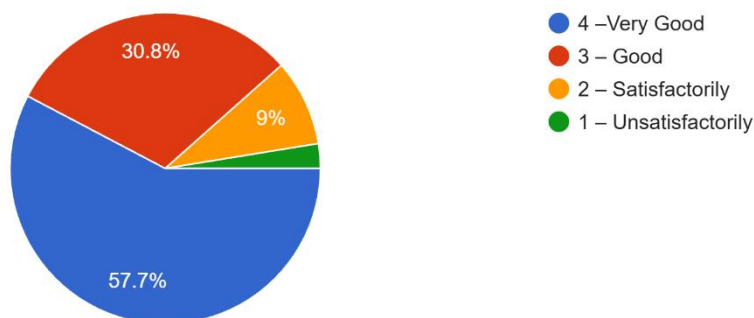
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1. Course content: (अभ्यासक्रमाची सामग्री)

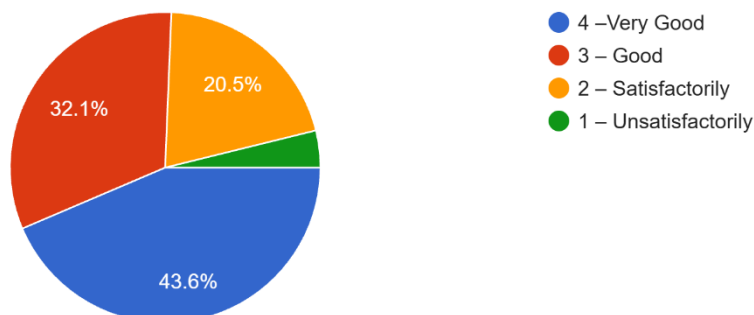


Analysis:

Based on the feedback received from **78 Alumni**, the evaluation of the **Course Content (अभ्यासक्रमाची सामग्री)** indicates a high level of satisfaction among the respondents. A majority of the **Alumni**, (57.7%) rated the course content as **Very Good**, while 30.8% rated it as **Good**, reflecting a strong positive perception of the curriculum. A small proportion of **Alumni** (approximately 9.0 %) considered the course content **Satisfactory**, and none of the respondents rated it as **Unsatisfactory**. Overall, the results demonstrate that the course content is well-structured, relevant, and effectively meets alumni' academic expectations, with **over 97% of alumni expressing positive feedback**.

2. Availability of reading material (Library /Internet/Others: (वाचन साहित्याची उपलब्धता (ग्रंथालय / इंटरनेट / इतर)

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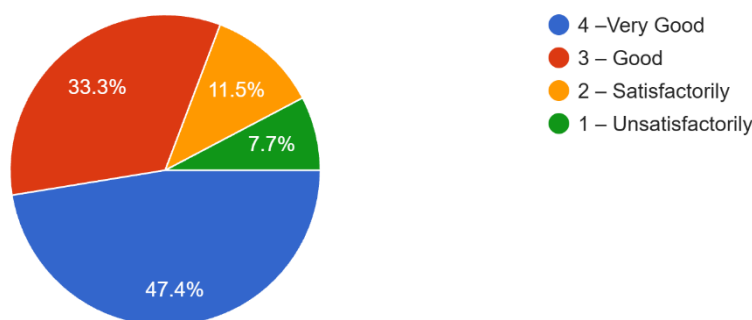


Analysis:

Based on the feedback collected from **78 alumni**, the responses regarding the **Availability of Reading Material (Library/Internet/Others)** indicate a generally positive perception among alumni. A majority of the respondents (**43.6%**) rated the availability of reading materials as **Very Good**, while **31.1%** rated it as **Good**, reflecting that most alumni are satisfied with the access to academic resources. However, **20.5%** of the alumni rated it as **Satisfactory**, and a very small percentage expressed **Unsatisfactory** feedback. Overall, about **75.7%** of the alumni provided positive ratings (**Very Good and Good**), suggesting that the institution provides adequate access to reading materials through the library, internet facilities, and other sources.

Analysis:

Based on the feedback received from **78 alumni**, the responses regarding the **Use of Innovative Teaching Methods (Group Discussion, Field Exercises, Role Play, etc.)** indicate a positive perception among the alumni. A majority of the respondents (**47.4%**) rated the use of innovative teaching methods as **Very Good**, while **33.3%** rated it as **Good**, showing that most alumni appreciate the adoption of interactive and participatory teaching approaches. About **11.5%** of the alumni rated it as **Satisfactory**, and **7.7%** alumni expressed **Unsatisfactory** feedback. Overall, **more than 80.7% of the alumni** provided positive ratings (**Very Good and Good**), indicating that the faculty effectively incorporate innovative and student-centric teaching practices to enhance learning experiences.



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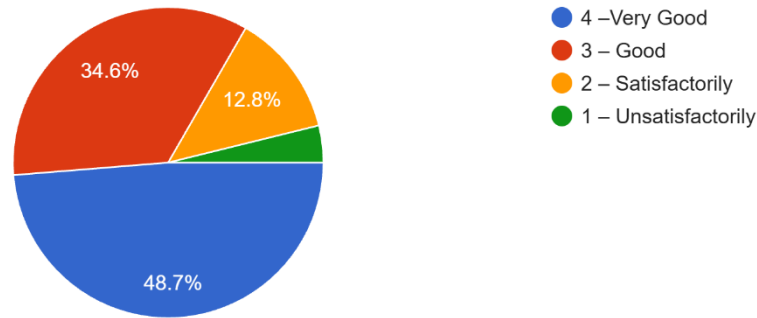

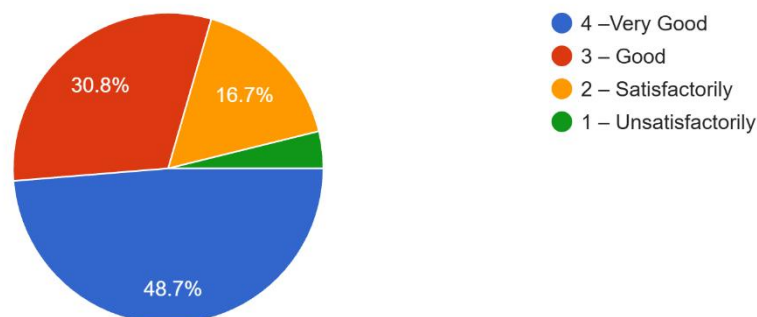


Analysis:

The feedback regarding learning value in terms of knowledge, conceptual understanding, manual skills, analytical abilities, and broadening of perspectives reflects a highly positive response from alumni.

A majority of respondents, **48.7%**, rated the learning value as **"Very Good,"** indicating that the institution effectively contributes to alumni' intellectual development and skill enhancement. Additionally, **34.6%** of respondents rated it as **"Good,"** demonstrating that a substantial proportion of stakeholders acknowledge the institution's strong academic environment and effective teaching-learning processes.

Analysis:

The analysis of the overall rating provided by 78 respondents indicates a highly positive perception of the institution's performance. A majority of respondents, **48.7%**, rated the institution



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as "Very Good," reflecting strong satisfaction with the quality of academic and institutional practices. Additionally, 30.8% of respondents rated the institution as "Good," further demonstrating that a significant proportion of stakeholders hold a favourable opinion of the institution. Only a small percentage of respondents rated the institution as "Satisfactory,"

7. Encourage student participation in research, innovation, cultural activities, and sports.
8. Strengthen the mentor–mentee system to provide better academic and personal support.
9. Collect student feedback regularly and take timely action to improve teaching quality.
10. Maintain a clean, safe, and student-friendly campus with reliable Wi-Fi and well-equipped laboratories.

Conclusion:

The feedback shown that alumni are generally very satisfied, with **teaching quality, Innovative Teaching Methods**. The key improvement areas are adopting modern and engaging pedagogical methods and enhancing access to academic resources.
